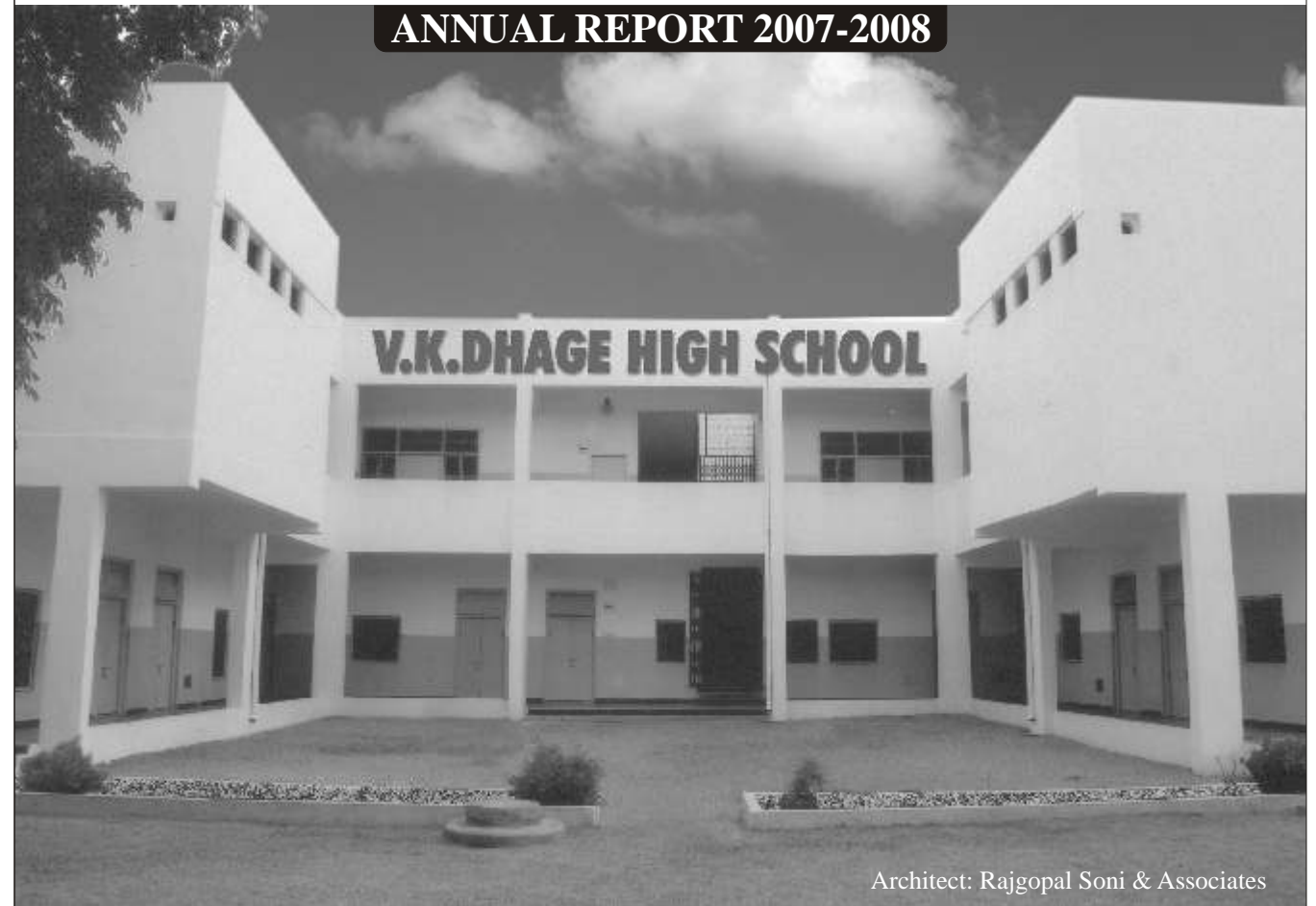

AN INTRODUCTION TO HYDERABAD CHILDREN'S AID SOCIETY

The Hyderabad Children's Aid Society is a Charitable Voluntary Organization established in 1950. The Society runs four homes for the purpose of good administration.

The Radha Kishan Home for children under 9 years, the Radha Kishan home for Small Boys under the age of 12 years and the Balika Bhavan for girls in the age group of 10 to 18 years are all situated at Nanalnagar. The Vejbai Bal Nivas for older boys is at Shivarampally. The children residing in the four homes are between the age of 5 to 18 years. All the children go to school or college. At Nanalnagar we have the V.K. Dhage Special Coaching Center i.e, from Nursery to class X.

Our academic performance is good and the Board exam results are encouraging. Children are encouraged to take part in sports, Art and Craft and all extra curricular activities. Some children go to private schools outside the premises. At present we have 277 children in the four home.

213 are at Nanalnagar and 64 are in Shivarampally.

Every year one health camp, one Eye Camp and one dental camp are conducted.

We have an Hon. Doctor, a moral Science Teacher and an Yoga Teacher who visit the Homes every week. The main aim of the Society is to give a happy childhood and value based education to poor destitute and orphan children.

The children are sheltered in airy spacious buildings with a big playground served Nutritious food and given decent clothing free of cost.

All festivals are celebrated in traditional style. We are happy that in the last 58 years we have given to the nation thousands of educated and civilized citizens.

All this is possible with the help of donors sponsors and well-wishers at home and abroad who contribute generously in cash and kind.

Without this help we would not be able to carry on the noble work of the founder couple Shri Venkat Krishnaji Dhage and Smt. Tehminabai Dhage who dedicated their whole life for the betterment of the underprivileged children of the Society.

VEJBAI BAL NIVAS A REPORT

Presented by Smt. Dinoo Khanna Hon. Secretary, Hyderabad Children's Aid Society at the 55th Anniversary Celebration of Vejbai Bal Nivas on 26th January, 2008.

It is my pleasure and privilege to present the report of Vejbai Bal Nivas which has served the underprivileged boys of the Society for 55 long years and a Home which has given to the nation thousands of educated and civilized citizens.

The Vejbai Bal Nivas a home for the needy underprivileged boys was started by Hyderabad Children's Aid Society on 2-1-1954. This Home devoted to children is associated with the name of Late Smt. Vejbai, mother of the initial donor Shri Tokarshi Lalji Kapadia.

Vejbai Bal Nivas was started with a modest strength of 11 boys and now the home shelters 61 boys. The total strength in the four homes run by the Society is 254.

At present Vejbai Bal Nivas is located in the buildings of the Sarvodaya Trust Campus at Shivarampally. One acre land and a building has been donated by Shri Tokarshi Lalji Kapadia to shelter the boys.

All the boys sheltered here are given free shelter nourishing food and decent clothing besides School uniforms and shoes. All the boys go to school or college and are given value based education and a happy childhood.

Boys are encouraged to take part in sports and other extra curricular activities.

Weekly moral science classes are conducted by Sri Satya Sai Baba Society. From time to time Yoga, Meditation and Art of Living classes are conducted. Majority of the boys go to the Zilla Parishad High School and some to Raghavendra Public High School.

Boys are taken out on educational excursions and to Science Exhibitions.

Vejbai Bal Nivas has been visited by great stalwarts like the President of India, Dr. Rajendra Pershad, The Vice-President of India, Dr. Sarvepalli Radha Krishnan, The Prime Minister of India, Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru, Shri Lal Bahadur Sastri and the Ex-Prime Minister Shri P.V. Narsimha Rao. They have all blessed the children and appreciated the work of the founders.

The past President of India Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy has been the President of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society from 1962 to 1967.

The founder of Vejbai Bal Nivas Shri Tokarshi Lalji Kapadia stood by Shri Venkat Krishnaji Dhage and Smt. Tehminabai Dhage the founders of Radha Kishan Home (run by The Hyderabad Children's Aid Society). Shri Tokarshi Lalji Kapadia's ideal contribution is the Sarvodaya Trust at Shivarampally. His smiling, Patient and persuading demeanor and method of approach endeared him to all communities. Among many others he won the national Viswa Gurjari Award.

He was the founder of the T.L. Kapadia Eye Bank. The Mahaveer Memorial Trust, Navjeevan Women's College, Nature Cure Hospital and Senior Citizen's Home at Shivarampally.

Shri Tokarshi Lalji Kapadia founder of Vejbai Bal Nivas will always be respectfully remembered as a great Philanthropist. And as the citizen of the world.

Over the last 55 years Vejbai Bal Nivas has given to the nation thousands of educated and civilized citizens.

There are advocates, Engineers, Pharmacists, Teachers, Industrialists, Businessmen, and officers in Public and Private Sectors. Many successful Students visit the Homes regularly and give financial contribution to the Society. Some old students help the present students with guidance in Maths and science. We are proud of them all.

Today I take this opportunity to thank all the sponsors, donors and well wishers At HOME and ABROAD.



THE STORY OF THE CENTER

Honourable Chief Guest Smt. Rama Devi, Guest of Honour Shri P.Vaman Rao, The President of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society Shri Dhirajlal Kapadia, Trustees of the V.K.Dhage Trust, Dignitaries on the dais, Ladies and Gentlemen.

I am honoured and privileged to present to you a report of the V.K.Dhage Special Coaching Center run by Hyderabad Children's Aid Society for the children residing in the Radha Kishan Homes.

The story of the center began in 1991. After the sad demise of the founder and the Secretary of the Society Mrs. Tehminabai Dhage on 27th June, 1990.

Dr. B.P. Rao the next Hon. Secretary of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society was an administrator an educationist and a retired Principal of the Prestigious Nizam College.

Dr. B.P. Rao laid the foundation of the V.K. Dhage Special Coaching Center on 27-06-1991 i.e. on the first death anniversary of the founder Mrs. Tehminabai Dhage, who was the Hon. Secretary from 6-5-1967 to 27-06-1990. This was the fittest memorial for the great soul.

The Special Coaching Center was started with two classes KG and 1st standard with 2 full time teachers.

From June, 1995 the school was upgraded to class 7th with 8 full time teachers. It was distinctly observed that the standard of education was becoming better with personal attention. The 7th class students appeared for Public examination as private candidates and came out with flying colours. On 27th June, 1996 the coaching center was shifted to the newly constructed nine class rooms building in the same premises.

Hon. Jt. Secretary of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society Mrs. Jeny Gupta who was already taking keen interest in children's education from 1991 took charge of the V.K.Dhage Special Coaching Center in January, 1999. Then there was no looking back. Our children excelled in both academics and extra curricular activities. Computer education was also introduced.

Mrs. Jeny Gupta left no stone unturned to maintain strict disciplinary standard. Our children became self confident and won prizes at the inter school quiz competition conducted by the All India Radio. The little artists of V.K.Dhage Special Coaching Center won the Nehru Cultural Award at the Young Envoys International Painting Competitions. Art and Craft exhibitions are held. Sports competitions are conducted on 26th January and 15th August and prizes are distributed to the winners. Cultural Programmes are organised every year, which are appreciated by one and all. To strengthen the value based education system moral science classes are conducted by Shri Satya Sai Baba Society, Art of living, meditation and Yoga Camps are regularly conducted by Mr. Srinivas and Sphoorthi Om Organisation.

In the year 2005 the center was further upgraded to class 10th and the girls appeared for the S.S.C. examination privately. The results have been encouraging. The center now has classes from Nursery to 10th Class. We now have 15 full time teachers.

A Social worker is also attached to the School.

The Credit for the good performance of the students is shared by the dedicated teachers to whom the management is deeply grateful.

The founder teachers are Mrs. Ramavathi, Mrs. Chandrakala, Mrs. Satyavani and Mrs. Vasanta, the management appreciates their devotion to duty.

In April, 2007 the management of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society decided to build more classrooms above the existing ones. An appeal was sent to all well-wishers and donors to contribute generously. Considering our performance the response has been very good. All the classrooms have been donated. In the new building we now have a computer room, a science Lab, a Library and an art and craft room. The total no. of rooms are 19. Very soon the School will be recognized by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The management of Hyderabad Children's Aid Society is deeply grateful to each and every donor without whose help this gigantic task would not have been successfully accomplished.

I am deeply grateful to Smt. Rama Devi for graciously accepting our invitation to be the Chief Guest Madam we are honoured! I am thankful to Mr. Vaman Rao for accepting our invitation to be the Guest of Honour Sir, your enthusiasm is an inspiration for us.



Shri Venkat Krishnaji Dhage and Smt. Tehminabai Dhage who are the founders of Radha Kishan Homes have devoted their whole life for the welfare of poor orphan and semi orphan children. Their life has been an exemplary one-A long saga of sacrifice.

The Radha Kishan Home was inaugurated by Dr. Sarvepally Radhakrishnan the then vice-President of India on 6th January, 1955.

The Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan was inaugurated by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru the then Prime Minister of India on 4th February, 1961.

In the past 55 years the society has given to the State/Nation thousands of educated responsible citizens.

The main aim of the organization is to give value-based education and a happy and comfortable childhood.

Guardians of orphans and poor widows not able to maintain their children bring them to our "Home", which has been providing not merely shelter but also giving them meaningful childhood which otherwise would have been denied to them.

OUR CHILDREN

At present we have 277 children under our care. They are divided into four Homes. We provide free shelter, nourishing food, decent clothing value based education and a happy and comfortable childhood. These children are between the ages of 5 to 18 years. All of them go to school or college and are living happily together.

Four homes are run by the Society:

1. Radha Kishan Home, (H.No.9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) for children between the ages 5-9 years shelters 41 children.
2. Radha Kishan Home for Small Boys, (H.No.9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) between the ages of 10-12 shelters 51 boys.
3. Radha Kishan Balika Bhavan, (H.No.9-4-78 & 79, Nanalnagar, Hyderabad-500 008) for girls between the ages of 10-18 years shelters 121 girls.
4. Vejbai Bal Nivas, (Opp Z.P.High School, Shivarampally, Near National Police Academy, Hyderabad-500 052) for boys at Shivarampally shelters 64 boys between the age of 12-18 years.

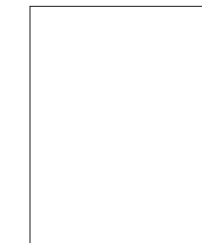

The V.K.Dhage High School renovation, which started in April, 2007 was completed in April, 2008. A separate report has been given. The school has costed Rs. 45,11,858=00. In 2007-2008 for various reason 40 children have gone home. Out of 40 Nine have finished School and Junior College.

Widow mother of the child or a guardian is allowed to meet the child on the 1st Sunday of every month. The child is allowed to go home during the month of May if the guardian can afford to do so.

The V.K.Dhage Special Coaching Center: - For better education and individual attention the center which was started in 1991 conducts classes for our children from Nursery to 10th class. Children appear for Board exam privately. Value based education is imparted. Academic performance is good. Confidence building is the keynote. The center has employed 15 sincere qualified teachers who maintain high standard of education. Sports and extra curricular activities are encouraged. Mrs. Jeny Gupta Hon. Jt. Secretary leaves no stone unturned to maintain high disciplinary standard.

The coaching center has a separate airy spacious building with a garden and a play ground in the same compound. Sports, Library, Art & Craft classes are also conducted.

The children are taken out on educational excursions.

New Activa Honda for office use has been received in August 07 costing Rs. 45,902=00.

An old Ayah Jayamma who served the Balika Bhavan for 20 years fell down and broke her leg. She has retired from work. Rs. 8,000/- was paid to her, as we have done in the past for other Ayahs (30th August, 07).

In September 07 letters were posted to parents who have adopted children from our Home in the last 15 years (they are all from Andhra Pradesh) to know about their progress. Some parents have sent all details of the child's progress with photos and some have told us in confidence that the child is growing up he/she is not aware of the adoption. The child considers them as their biological parents and would be hurt if the truth comes to light. Some have shown the happily growing children to us just as friends, without disclosing our identity to the child. All the children are happily growing and studying well. One adopted girl Renuka got married on 13th September, 07. Our staff attended the marriage and got family photos.

New clothes were also distributed to the staff on Dassera festival and Diwali cash gift was given.

Radha Kishan Home adoption case was postponed from 25th June, 07, to 4th September, 07, to 5th December, 07, to 5th March, 08 to 26th March, 08 to 23rd June, 2008 to 21st July, 08.

26th January, 2008, 55 years of Vejbai Bal Nivas was celebrated. Mrs. Sabita Indra Reddy, Minister for Mines and Geology was the Chief Guest.
